- 12. A question.

Pictures (Sheet Two) Draw in the boxes:

- 1. Something that makes you laugh.
- 2. Something that you saw earlier today.
- 3. Something that happened in a dream.
- 4. Your favourite animal.
- 5. Your least favourite food.
- 6. Something out-of-this-world.
- 7. Something you can see from the window.
- 8. An object on the table/in the same room as you.
